Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriages - There are 4 sizes of hook type tine carriages rated by the fork carriage hoisting capacity. Hook type fork carriages have been the same.

Class I carriages are rated for cargo as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for Class I is 13 inches. Class II carriages are rated for cargo up to 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is 25 inches.

The carriages for pin type tines can be different depending on the manufacturer. Pin mounted blades can differ by the amount of offset between the fork eye and the tine. Carriage capacity will be determined by the carriage pin size and by the blade size.
